This is a template of how to format an Abstract for ICCARUS (ICON COSMO CLM ART User Seminar). We accept plain text abstracts, which might contain  $IAT_EX$  commands and formulas. The title, the name(s) of author(s), their affiliation(s) and the text of the abstract have to be put into our web form.

To use  $IAT_EX$  commands, the best is to prepare your abstract within this template without adding any further  $IAT_EX$  packages. Do not use sections, figures, fancy formatting or own macros, e.g., shortcuts for mathematical operators etc. If you can process this document successfully through  $IAT_EX$ , then it will also work in our system.

Author(s) and Affiliation(s) should be specified in exactly the above way as comma-separated lists. In the **\author{}** command, use numbers in brackets after each author's name to indicate different affiliations. Authors with same affiliation should have the same number. In the **\affil**{} command, the affiliation(s) should be listed with the affiliation number in brackets first, followed by the affiliation name, a comma, the next affiliation name, and so on.

Once you are done, please **copy-and-paste** the content of the above **\title{**} command into the "Title of abstract" field of the web form. Similarly, copy-and-paste the content of the **\author{}** command into the "Authors(s)" field and the contents of the **\affil{}** command into the "Affiliation(s)" field.

Finaly, copy-and-paste all your text between \maketitle and \end{document} into the "Abstract" field.
